



## Application to enter NSW via the Queensland Cattle tick infected zone

This form is to be completed for both PRIMARY Hosts (cattle, buffalo, bison, deer) and SECONDARY Hosts (sheep, goats, horses, and camelids) entering NSW via the Qld Cattle Tick Infected zone.

It is an offence to introduce stock into NSW carrying cattle tick. Ensure that stock are tick free prior to movement. Maximum penalty for false and misleading information is \$11,000.

All applications must be accompanied by copies of any NVD / waybills, any treatment certificates (e.g. preliminary treatment declarations, Cattle Tick inspection and treatment certificate), travel permits or other appropriate documentation.
